## Weekly Dose Grade 1 indicators and capitalization

RULE A grade 1 indicator precedes a capitalization indicator.

Example:

T-REX ON SALE! 

*“Should I use a grade 1 indicator if the work is ALL uncontracted?”*

RULE If Braille material is ALL UNCONTRACTED, the grade 1 indicators are not used. However, e.g. for the lowercase letters a-j immediately following digits, and a question mark in an unusual position, the grade 1 indicators are used.

Examples:

B is the first letter of my last name.
