

Weekly Dose Slash STOPS Capitalized Word and Numeric Indicator

RULE A slash terminates the effect of the capitalized word indicator and the numeric indicator; therefore, when a slash occurs between two numbers or two capitalized words or abbreviations, the numeric indicator or capitalized word indicator is repeated after the slash. The capitalized passage indicator is only ever terminated by the specific passage terminator, and so the effect of the passage indicator carries through the slash. Remember, when in passage mode it keeps going and going until stopped.

EXAMPLES:

USA/STEM

Model 5/777

PAN/aj

BACKUP ONTO CLOUD/SAVE RECORDS
