Weekly Dose Apostrophe Replacing Numbers

RULE When a print number is preceded by an apostrophe, in braille the apostrophe is placed before the number indicator.

EXAMPLE

Is '77 the number for the ticket?

Did you notice anything in the above example? Dot 3 [apostrophe] is placed before dots 3456 [numeric indicator]. Remember, the numeric indicator must precede the braille cell it affects, like Capitalization Mode. Dot 6 [capitals symbol indicator] must precede a letter that is to be shown as a capital letter.
