Weekly Dose Apostrophe Replacing Numbers

RULE When a print number is preceded by an apostrophe, in braille the apostrophe is placed **before** the number indicator.

EXAMPLE

Is '77 the number for the ticket?

Did you notice anything in the above example? Dot 3 [apostrophe] is placed before dots 3456 [numeric indicator]. Remember, the numeric indicator must precede the braille cell it affects, like Capitalization Mode. Dot 6 [capitals symbol indicator] must precede a letter that is to be shown as a capital letter.
