## Weekly Dose Comparing: Typeform Indicator and the Capitals Passage Indicator

**“It is true that when a braille transcriber uses the Capital Passage Indicator, this would ensure capitalization mode will go on and on until the capitals terminator is used?”  
Yes, that is correct!**

**“But does this understanding apply to the typeform passage indicator?” The answer, yes!**

**“How does this work when applying this method to a list?”**

**RULE** When the *capitals or typeform passage indicator* extends over more than one text element, **each** text element is preceded by the capitals or typeform passage indicator and the capitals or typeform mode is terminated only at the end of the final text element. Remember, the typeform mode is terminated only at the point where the typeform changes.
