Weekly Dose Contractions Say No to Shortforms

RULE Do not use shortforms as parts of words if their use would work against a basic contraction rule.

Example 1

The shortform for *before* cannot be used in *hereinbefore* because to use the *be* contraction, which is part of the shortform, it must be the first syllable of the word.

Example 2

The shortform *conceive* cannot be used in *misconceive*, because the *con* sign does not start at the beginning of the word.
