Weekly Dose Definition List Reminders

RULE: Entry words are contracted ONLY, and are <u>not repeated</u> in uncontracted form.

- a. Ignore font attributes, except when distinction is required.
- b. Leave ONE BLANK CELL between an entry word and its definition, NOT TWO, when the entry word is followed by punctuation, or if the definition starts with an uppercase letter.

Example:

Integrity: The quality of being honest and having strong moral principles; moral uprightness.

c. Leave TWO BLANK CELLS between entries and definitions when the entry words are phrases instead of individual words, if they are not followed by punctuation, or if the definition begins with a lowercase letter.

Example:

Integrity The quality of being honest and having strong moral principles; moral uprightness.

Learning point: Did you notice in the two examples above, the Boldface Word Indicator was not used for the word **Integrity**.
