Weekly Dose Enough

RULE: The *lower wordsign*, **enough**, is used when standing alone, and unlike be, were, his, and was, it CAN be used when in contact with lower punctuation signs provided the sequence contains upper dots.

Examples:

Far-enough :: :: :: :: ::

Reminder Rule: The *lower wordsigns* for be, his, was, were, and enough cannot be used next to a slash because they must always stand alone.

Example:

RULE: Watch out! To prevent it from being misread as "enough", do not use the lower groupsign for "en" when the letters "en" are "standing alone".
