Weekly Dose "Follow Print"

Time to break it down into bite size pieces. Here are some non-technical examples from the *Rules of Unified English Braille* 2013 that may need a closer look to understand, keep reading and pay attention to the wording.

RULE Follow Print

Is the print symbol slanted or not slanted? Knowing this answer will determine how you transcribe print into braille. Keep reading!

General Symbols: Feet ':: Inches "::: [directional, SLANTED]

BUT...

General Symbols: Feet I.: Inches II.: [nondirectional, NOT SLANTED are also used for nondirectional single quote and nondirectional double quotation marks that are shown in print.]

Hint: Always use the surrounding text in deciding how to transcribe!
