

## Weekly Dose Grade 1 Passage Indicator

**Question:** How do you know when to use the grade 1 passage indicator?

**Suggested Answer:** Grade 1 passage indicator is used to provide ease of readability for the reader and by using the grade 1 passage indicator less braille cells are used.

**RULE** The grade 1 passage indicator sets grade 1 mode for the next passage. A grade 1 passage is terminated by the grade 1 terminator.

**RULE** The grade 1 terminator usually follows immediately after the last affected symbols-sequence of a grade 1 passage. Use the grade 1 terminator when it is necessary to terminate grade 1 mode before the end of a symbols-sequence.

### Example 5.4.2:

He spelt H-o C-h-i M-i-n-h City.

*[Did you notice in the previous example; there are three symbols-sequences? Which would require the use of a passage indicator.]*
