## Weekly Dose Grade 1 Word Indicator Reminder

**RULE** The grade 1 word indicator :: sets grade 1 mode for the next symbols-sequence or the remainder of the current symbols-sequence.

**RULE** The effect of a grade 1 word indicator is terminated by a space or a grade 1 terminator.

## Example

I am so h-a-p-p-y today.

```

```

In the example below, remember to use the grade 1 terminator, otherwise, no contractions would be permitted for the remainder of the braille sequence.

[This is often a forgotten step when transcribing classroom worksheets.]
