Weekly Dose Hyphen or Dash Ends Grade 1 Mode

RULE Grade 1 mode is terminated by a hyphen or dash, thus allowing contractions to be used again. Therefore, a letter or letters that could read as a contraction will need the grade 1 indicator.

EXAMPLE

```
If you go 1st—will I go last?

Collector's 8-CD box set.

[A quick capitalised word indicator reminder.

Dot 6, dot 6 MUST precede the letters it directly effects.]

6—more make a dozen

10-yr equals 1 decade spent in time
```
