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## Weekly Dose Hyphenated Word Division

**RULE** When a hyphenated word is divided at the existing hyphen, retain the normal braille form of the word.

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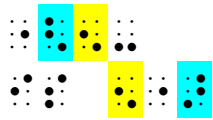

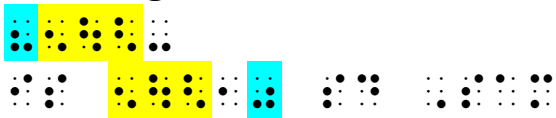

**RULE** Remember, if this pattern consisted only of lower signs, DO NOT use the lower wordsign.
