

Weekly Dose Isolated Punctuation Emphasized

Classroom print worksheets display a lot of highlighting, color coding, especially with grammar and punctuation. The example below will show you as a transcriber how to correctly transcribe in braille.

RULE When isolated punctuation is emphasized with something other than italics, bold, underlining, or script, insert a transcriber's note after the punctuation mark or applicable word to identify the print emphasis.

EXAMPLE

Do you want to meet at the Hippo's Zoo in the park?

[Also, if you notice the transcriber note is not structured like a sentence, only a word description.]
