

Weekly Dose Literary Digits and Spacing

Follow print for order, spacing, capitalization and punctuation of abbreviations. Not sure of spacing? It is recommended that a **space is inserted** in the braille.

Examples:

Add 1 can of beans, 1 c of flour, 2 T of oil.

One complete orbit lasts 2yr 5m 15d 7h 17min.

[Notice how the letters

for 17min are NOT contracted, it is numeric mode, no contractions are used in numeric mode.]

The reading is 15 mHz.

Is the speed limit 30 mph or 50 km/h?
