

Weekly Dose Medial Punctuation and Indicator

RULE When punctuation, an indicator or a terminator occurs within a word, follow print, and follow the basic contraction rules of Sections 10.1 to 10.11.

Examples:

knowledge ⠠⠎⠞⠔⠑⠗⠏⠁⠝⠊⠎⠑

"just"ice ⠠⠵⠽⠠⠠⠠⠠⠠⠠ [The alphabetic wordsign
 "just" cannot be used it is not standing alone.]

go'n 𐄂𐄂𐄂𐄂 [The alphabetic wordsign "go" cannot be used because it is not standing alone.]

rub**b**'d ::::: [Did you notice in this example the lower group**sign** **bb** are followed by an apostrophe so the lower group**sign** cannot be used because it not followed by a letter or a contraction?]
