**RULE** When punctuation, an indicator or a terminator occurs within a word, follow print, and follow the basic contraction rules of Sections 10.1 to 10.11.

Examples:

knowledge

"just"ice :: :: :: :: [The alphabetic wordsign "just" cannot be used it is not standing alone.]

go'n :::: [The alphabetic wordsign "go" cannot be used because it is not standing alone.]

rubb'd :: :: [Did you notice in this example the lower groupsign bb are followed by an apostrophe so the lower groupsign cannot be used because it not followed by a letter or a contraction?]
