Capitalized Passage Indicator AND Non-Alphabetic Symbol

Capitalized Passage Indicator ::::

8.5.1 The capitalized passage indicator sets capitals mode for the next passage.

8.5.2 A passage is three or more symbols-sequences and it may include non-alphabetic symbols.

EXAMPLE:

FOR SALE TODAY ONLY: 1985 TRUCK

SIGN READS: BUY TOMORROW 1/2 DOZEN EGGS AT THE E-STORE CORNER

Learning point: Even though the Capitalized Passage Indicator is being implemented, the numeric indicator (non-alphabetic symbol) DOES NOT end the Capitalization mode.

Extra credit learning point: Did you notice that the numeric indicator was used AGAIN after the forward slash symbol?

Rule: In literary work, when print is written linearly using an ordinary forward slash symbol the numeric indicator is used **again** after the forward slash.
