## Weekly Dose Order of Positions

## **EXAMPLE 1:**

When transcribing dates, time, coinage, ordinal numbers, postal codes or telephone numbers: follow print punctuation and order of symbols.

EXAMPLE 2: Close punctuation and indicators in reverse order of opening.

```
He shouted "I WILL NOT!"
```

## **EXAMPLE 3:**

When braille requires the use of two (or more) different typeform indicators for the same text, the indicators and terminators are best nested – meaning that the first typeform to be opened is the last typeform to be closed.

```
Pecunia Felicitatibus Honoratur. Money welcomed gladly.
```
