

Weekly Dose Pronunciation Basics

RULE Following are the common guidelines for all pronunciation. Additional information unique to different types of pronunciation is discussed later in this section.

- Contractions may be used in a word when the pronunciation of the word is featured.
- Use modified letter indicators to represent print diacritic marks.
- Divide syllabified words that do not fit on one braille line at a syllable break.

Examples:

\ah•vant-GARD\
moh TEEF

(ad-ap-TAY-shun)

|ad ap *tay* shun|

adaptayshun
