## **Weekly Dose Punctuation and Indicators**

When punctuation, an indicator or a terminator occurs within a word, follow print and follow the basic contraction rules.

## **EXAMPLE**

```
knowledge
```

QUESTION: So why do we not contract this alphabetic wordsign, it is standing alone?

ANSWER: RULE Preferably do not use the alphabetic wordsign when it is known, or can be determined from the text, or by reference to a standard dictionary, that the letters the wordsign represents are pronounced separately as in an acronym or abbreviation.
