Weekly Dose
Question Mark used AFTER a hyphen

RULE: Place a grade 1 symbol indicator before a question mark which follows a space, hyphen or dash and any of the punctuation and indicator symbols listed below.

- opening parenthesis (round bracket), opening square bracket or opening curly bracket (brace bracket)
- opening quotation mark of any kind
- nondirectional quotation mark of any kind
- apostrophe
- opening typeform indicator of any kind
- capitals indicator of any kind

EXAMPLE:

Say wh-? 

In this example, the grade 1 symbol indicator is used before the question mark.
