Weekly Dose Typeform Indicators for Early Educational Materials

RULE Kindergarten, very important, ALL font attributes are OMITTED and should be put into a transcriber's note on the Teacher's Reference Material's Page.

RULE First Grade font attributes should be used ONLY when necessary. If necessary, use the Italics may be used for both the bold and italics. Remember, if you have to show more than one font attributes for a teaching, then yes, you will need to use both separately.

RULE Second and Third Grade Font attributes MAY BE used, but still kept to a minimum. If highlighted or colored word(s), use the transcriber-defined typeform indicators. Always, put indicators on the Special Symbols list both in print and braille.

Example
