## **Weekly Dose Typeforms and Punctuation**

- Follow print when determining whether to place punctuation before or after a typeform indicator.
- Typeform indicators and paired symbols such as parentheses and quotes should be nested—that is, closed in the reverse order in which they were opened.
- If in print it is not clear whether the typeface is applied to the punctuation, assume that it is applied, except for a dash, hyphen, or ellipsis.
