## Choice of capitalized indicators

**Note**: While the default treatment for a sequence of capital letters is capitals word mode, there are situations where the transcriber has a choice between using either individual capital letters or capitals word mode. If both choices will render an unambiguous transcription, interpret the following rules as guidelines.

• Choose the method which retains the usual braille form.

```
EXAMPLE: OK OKd
```

• Choose the method which best conveys the meaning. In particular, choose a method that avoids the need for capital indicators or terminators within natural subunits of an expression.

```
EXAMPLE: TVOntario
```

• Choose the method which gives consistency throughout a single title.
