7.5.4 Place a grade 1 symbol indicator before a question mark which follows a space, hyphen or dash.

Examples:

```
?-1950
```

The question mark is standing alone when next to a hyphen.

```
(?—1950)
```

The question mark is standing alone when next to a dash.

```
Replace each ? with a letter: ?f??u
```

Did you notice the grade 1 symbol indicator is used before the ?f??u because dots 236 can be misread as a quotation mark.
