

Weekly Dose Wordsigns

RULE: Use the alphabetic wordsign when the word it represents is "standing alone".

EXAMPLE: As You Like It ⠠⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠⠠

RULE: Use the alphabetic and strong wordsign when the word it represents is followed by an apostrophe with the following letters: d, ll, re, s, t, ve, BUT it MUST BE standing alone.

EXAMPLE:

you'd ⠠⠠⠠⠠⠠

this'd ⠠⠠⠠⠠⠠

which'll ⠠⠠⠠⠠⠠⠠

One more RULE reminder: DO NOT USE an alphabetic or strong wordsign next to a solidus, why, because it would not be standing alone.

EXAMPLE:

you/ ⠠⠠⠠⠠⠠ that/ ⠠⠠⠠⠠⠠⠠
