Mixing Apostrophes and Capitalized Word Indicator

QUESTION: Working on a literature worksheet and not sure how to transcribe titles that are in all capital letters and using several apostrophes?

Taking a closer look at the rules.

Capitalized Word Indicator

RULE The capitalized word indicator sets capitals mode for the next letters-sequence or the remainder of the current letters-sequence.

RULE The effect of a capitalized word indicator is terminated by a space, a single capital letter, a nonalphabetic symbol, or a capitals terminator, but not by a modifier or a ligature indicator.

EXAMPLE

JACK'S FO'C'S'LE

HERE THE SECOND CORRECT
