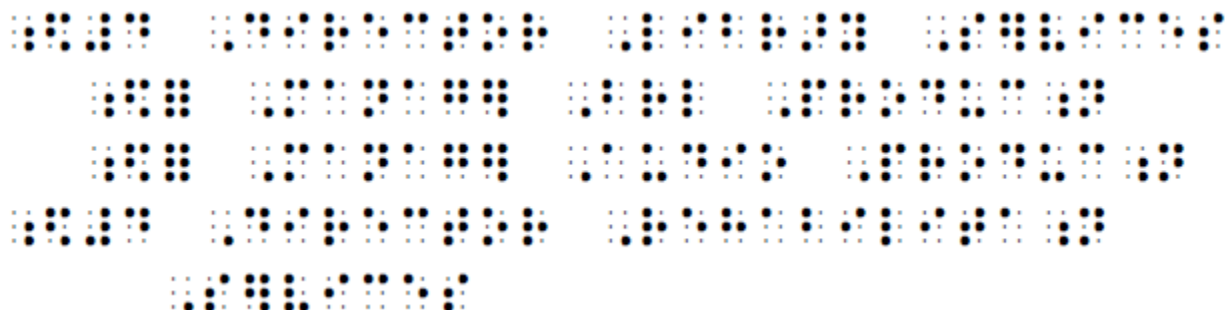


*"What is the difference between non-technical and technical material? Trying to research how to transcribe these circles and squares shown in an outline. Help!"*

In general, Non-Technical Material uses UEB literary, general reading materials whereas Technical Materials uses Nemeth Code with UEB to include mathematics and science.

- In non-technical material, list the complete shape symbol (without any grade 1 indicator) and its meaning on the symbols page or in a transcriber's note.
- A grade 1 indicator may need to be added before the symbol in the text of the document being transcribed.
