### **SPACING [1.4]**

#### **Kindergarten and first grade: Double-space, but...**

##### **Single-space:**

- title pages
- puzzles
- Spatial problems in math textbooks
- Titles of tactile graphics
- Chart/tables
- Column heading and separation line
- Alphabetic page number
- DO NOT insert a blank line after the top box line and before the bottom box line.

#### **Second and third grades: Single-space ALL materials**
